### **AS A REMINDER TO ALL TRAVELING FAMILIES**

All traveling citizens are now required to present a passport when traveling to Canada. Please note that on June 1, 2009, the U.S. government implemented the full requirements of the land and sea phase of the Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI). The rules require most U.S. citizens entering the United States at sea or land ports of entry to have a passport, passport card, or WHTI-compliant document. **Please also note that all children regardless of age, including newborns and infants, must have their own passport.** Don't wait! ### **ACTIVITIES**

Activities include exciting themes, arts & crafts, group games, music & movement, board games, story time, dramatic play, etc. We provide activities appropriate for each age group, using safe, sturdy equipment that you can feel comfortable with. Children can make their own choices within KiddieCorp's program.

### **COMMITMENT**

Our goal is to provide your children with a comfortable, safe and happy experience. Our staff to child ratios are high to ensure that every child feels special (1:2 for children ages 6 through 11 months; 1:3 for children ages 1 through 2 years old; 1:5 for children ages 3 through 5 years old; 1:7 for children ages 6 through 12 years old). KiddieCorp team members are selected according to their integrity, experience, education and enthusiasm. They must be wonderful with kids! You will feel extra secure knowing that the KiddieCorp team is bonded and that we carry ample liability insurance.

KiddieCorp staff does not administer medication. To ensure a safe and fun-filled environment, any child who is ill will not be admitted to the children's program. Please label your child's belongings. We will maintain a lost and found, however, KiddieCorp does not accept responsibility for the loss or theft of any toy, book, or other personal items. For parents with infants, please bring diaper changing supplies, formula/baby food, and a change of clothes.

### **WHERE, WHEN, FOR WHOM**

The program is for children ages 6 months through 12 years old. The dates for the program are August 5-10, 2009 and will be located at the Delta Centreville in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. Snacks and beverages will be provided and meals can be supplied by parents or purchased when checking in your child each day. KiddieCorp and the World Science Fiction Convention highly recommend registering your children for no more than 6 to 8 consecutive hours of care at any one time. Please feel free to visit the program and check your children in and out throughout the day.

### **REGISTRATION**

See the attached registration and consent form for event information. There must be an adult registered with the conference to be able to register a child for the children's program. The advance registration deadline is July 22, 2009. Register early as availability is limited and handled on a first-come, first-served basis. KiddieCorp must receive both the registration/consent form and payment in full to hold reservations. Although every effort will be made to accommodate on-site registrations, there is no guarantee and it is not recommended.

**REGISTRATION FEES:**

Child membership rates are valid until April 30th, 2009 and grant full benefits to Anticipation for children aged 6–12 (born on or after August 6th, 1996 and on or before August 5th, 2003) at the time of the convention. Children aged 5 and under (born after August 5th, 2003) get into the convention for free. Childcare fees not included with the membership. In order to register a child for childcare you or the person you are with must have a membership. The cost to pre-register for the children's program is \$9.00 (US Currency) per hour, per child (2-hour minimum required per child, per day).

The cost for late or on-site registration is \$12.00 (US Currency) per hour, per child or \$14.00 (Canadian Currency) per hour, per child (2-hour minimum required per child, per day).
